# Proposed Assignment of Session #77 Input Documents

## Abstract

This document proposes the assignment of Session #77 input documents.

## Introduction

On 1 January 2012, the IEEE 802.16 Working Group (WG) initiated use of the IEEE 802.16 Mentor documentation system <<http://doc.wirelessman.org>>, based on IEEE's Mentor Documents system, for storage and distribution of working group documents and contributions.

In the current process, documents are organized according to "Document Groups" that are identified by four-symbol "file codes." The current set of file codes is organized into three "Group-Oriented File Codes":

The Project-Oriented File Codes are intended to identify contributions to specific ongoing standards development projects under active PARs. Hence, the assignment of these documents to specific task groups is relatively simple, assuming that the contributions were accurately identified by the contributors.

On the other hand, the Group-Oriented File Codes represent documents that are relevant to larger issues and therefore, in general, are more likely to be of interest to the entire Working Group (WG). In some cases, they could be addressed and disposed of during a WG Plenary Meeting. In other cases, they may be best assigned to a subgroup for review and possible action but the WG should nevertheless be notified and aware of the issues raised and should be responsible to track the followup.

### Proposed Session Process

Under the new document system, it becomes incumbent on the WG Opening Plenary Meeting to review the input documents, with a focus on the Group-Oriented Gdocs, Gcons, and WGLSs, addressing some in the Plenary and assigning others to review by appropriate Task Groups.

It would be most helpful for the WG to have an preliminary assignment of documents available for review during the Opening Plenary.

## Proposal

This Proposed Assignment of Group-Oriented Input Documents should be reviewed at the WG Opening Plenary. The WG should agree on the proposed assignments, modified as appropriate. Late documents should be included at the will of the WG. The approved assignments should be recorded in a revision of this document and noted in the minutes.

I suggest that the WG agree to assigned all Project-Oriented documents to the Task Group responsible for the project denoted in the File Code, unless an erroneous File Code is brought to the attention of the WG at the Plenary. Should errors later be discovered by the TG, it should act to bring the matter to the attention of the appropriate TG and, in any case, note the issue at the WG Closing Plenary.

At the Closing Plenary, the WG should review the document list and ensure that all documents have been addressed, make a record of which ones have not been addressed, and ensure a record for the following session of documents carried forward to that session for further discussion.
