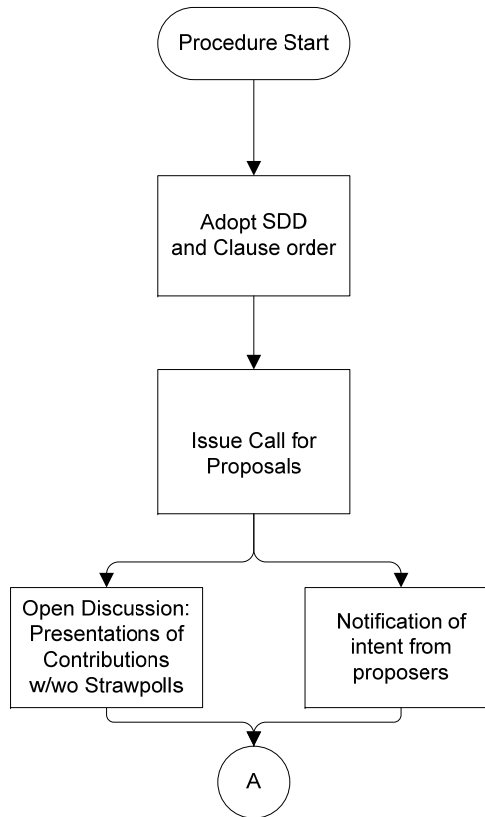

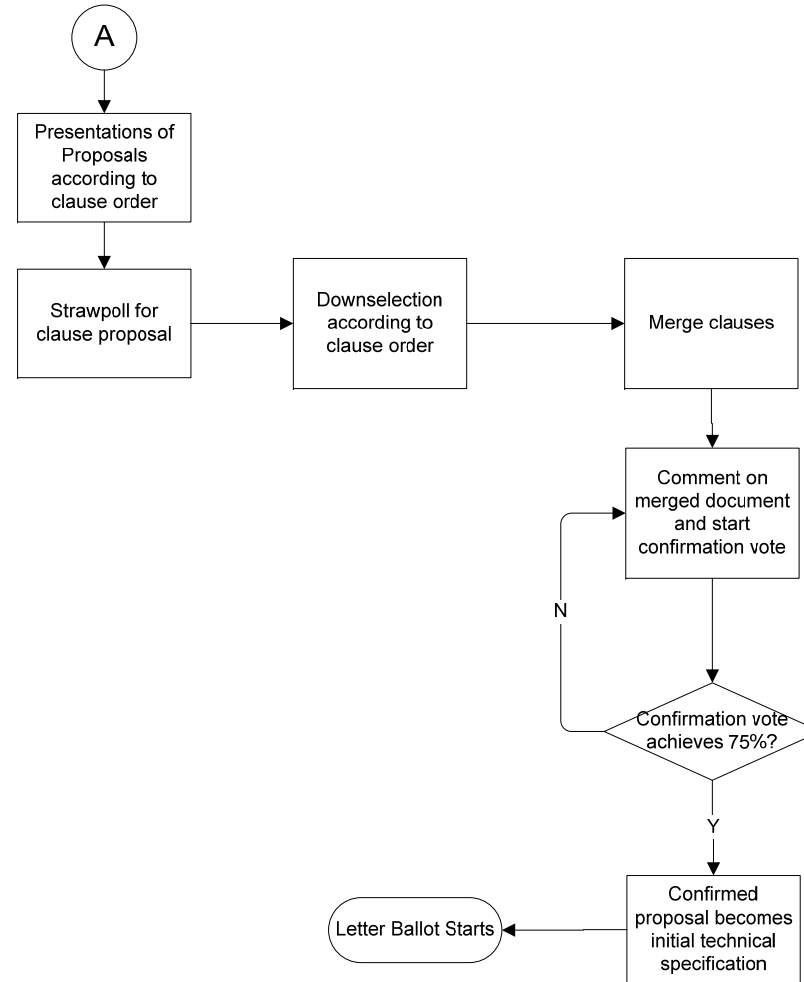
Main Steps of the Process

1. Create SDD and DECIDE on clauses and downselection order of technical clauses based on SDD.
2. CALL for proposals on all clauses based on SDD and SDD outline.
3. OPEN DISCUSSION: Open discussion of contributions. If contributor wants there can be a strawpoll for the contribution. (Phase 1)
4. NOTIFICATION: Proposers should announce which clauses they want to propose up to 2 months after the call for proposals.
5. PRESENT: Proposals grouped and presented by clause order defined by the group. Proposals should be submitted with accompanying text file one week before Monday of the presentation session. After all presentations of a given clause, take straw poll to select most favored by the group. (Phase 2)
6. DOWNSELECT: When all clauses have been presented, downselection should start. Before downselection it is possible to merge proposals. For each clause based on order, vote on proposals in group. In each round proposal with fewest votes is eliminated. Repeat until only one clause proposal remains. Last proposal needs to have more than %50 percent approval from TG. (Phase 2)
7. MERGE: When all clauses have voted proposal, editor merges and presents draft for additional work.
8. COMMENT: Have one comment ballot inside the group to improve the draft.
9. CONFIRM: Have a confirmation vote to start LB in the group.
10. START LB: Begin formal WG LB if the resulting draft has %75 percent off approval in confirmation vote. If not go to COMMENT step.

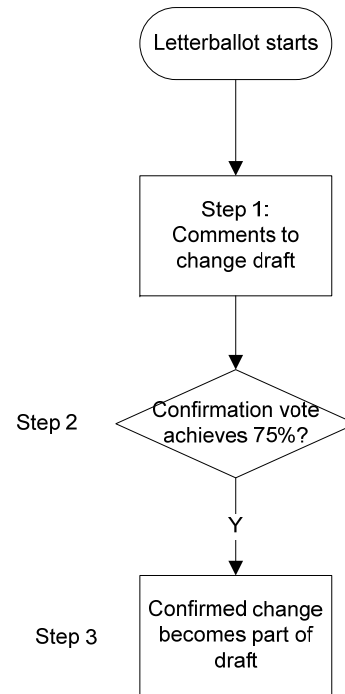
802.19.1 Process until Letterballot 1/2



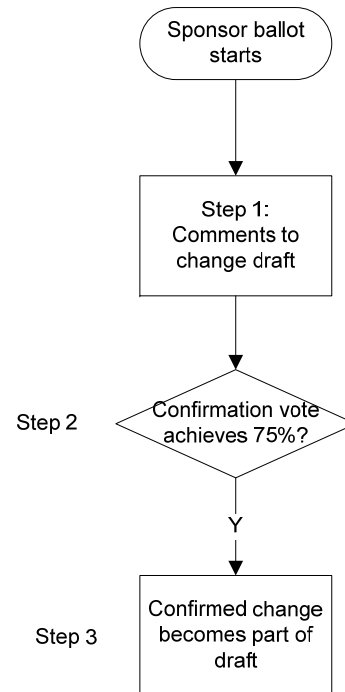
802.19.1 Process until Letterballot 2/2

Aggressive Time Plan
