- ➔ To progress and complete P1900.4.1 standard, precise design is needed.
- ➔ Since it is the inter-connection among standardised wireless systems, the WG should seek for possibilities to collaborate with other standardisation groups.
 - Call for proposals/contributions from other groups
 - Liaison with those groups
 - Candidates include: IEEE 802, ComSoc, ETSI RRS, 3GPP, Wireless Innovation Forum, and etc.

A Way Forward – cont'd

- ➔ Chair and WG leadership will make promotion activities to those groups by:
 - surveying their activities and status;
 - creating tutorial materials including how P1900.4.1 fits with those standards; and
 - presenting that to targeted groups.
