- Planned publication date (end of April)

WG6 status – new PAR

- PAR (*IEEE Standard for Spectrum Sensing Interfaces and Data Structures for Dynamic Spectrum Access and other Advanced Radio – Amendment: Procedures, Protocols and Data Archive Enhanced Interfaces*) developed, approved by working group and by Sponsor.
- PAR has been submitted on the SA platform (March 10th 2011) and has now been put on the agenda for the next NesCom meeting (May 6th 2011).

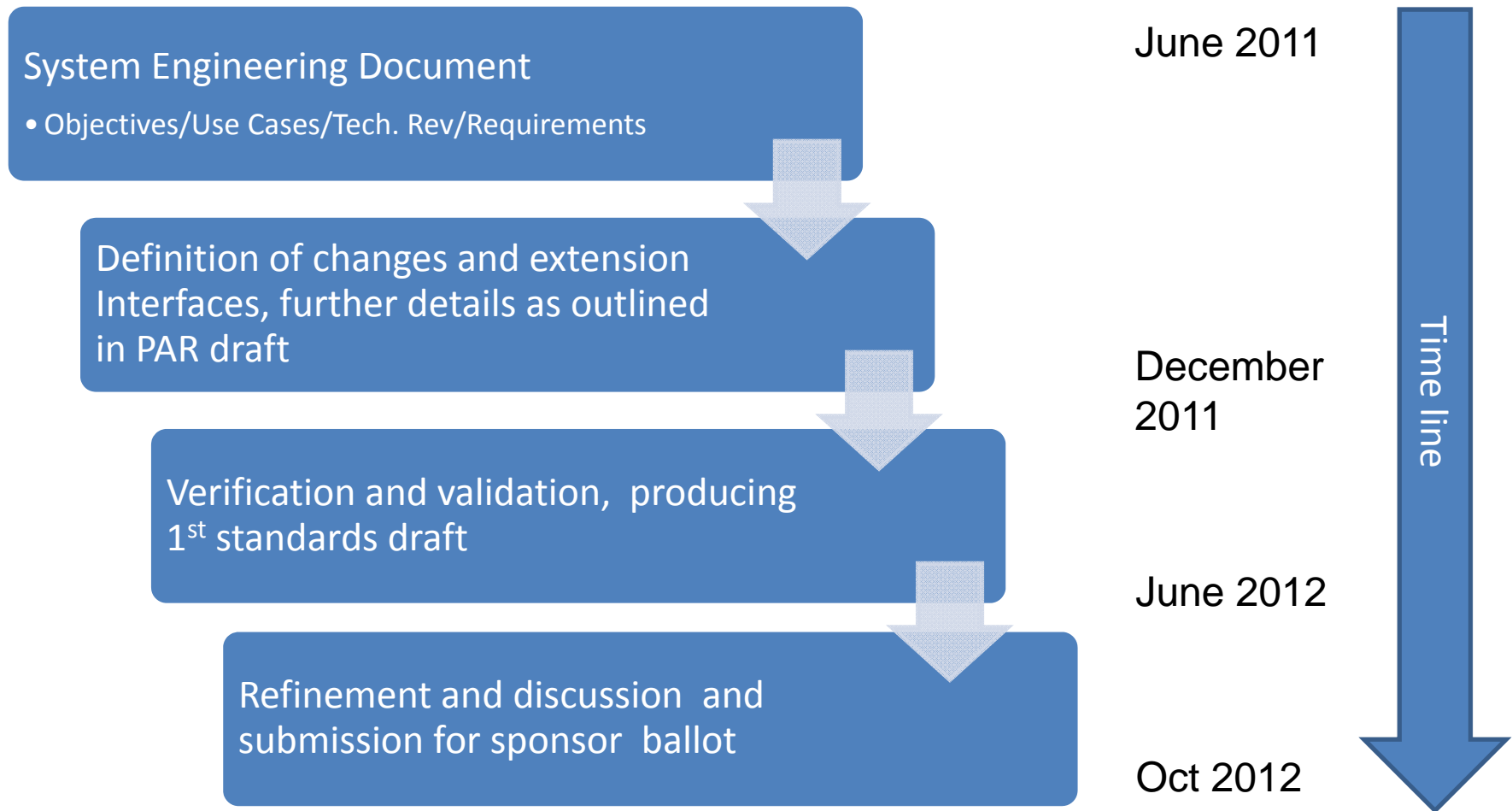
WG6 Status – P&P

- Initial technical presentations have been made, further technical discussion is needed leading towards the initial definition of the System Engineering Documents.
